**AMENDED ORDER APPROVING BID, CONFIRMING TAX SALE
AND DISBURSING PROCEEDS OF PAYMENT**

THIS CASE came to be heard on the Report of the Special Commissioner, Brandi Law, counsel for the Plaintiff, the City of Hampton, Virginia (the “City”), and their motion for approval of bid submitted by Richard Epstein (the “Highest Bidder”), confirmation of the sale of the property at issue in this suit (the “Property”) and disbursement of the sale proceeds after they are paid into the Special Commissioner’s office.

It appearing to the Court that:

1. On October 19, 2015, the City filed suit to sell the Property, designated 319 Ivy Home Road- Parcel ID 02F016 00 00026A- RPC 2002133 and more particularly described on Schedule A of the Complaint, for payment of the real estate taxes and other charges owing thereon.

2. On September 15, 2016, the Special Commissioner put the Property to public auction at which the Highest Bidder bid \$35,000.00 (the “Bid Price”), a fair and reasonable price for the property, made a down payment of \$8,000.00 and agreed to pay the balance, plus recording costs.

3. The Highest Bidder will deposit a total of \$38,616.67 (Bid Price of \$35,000.00 plus recording costs of \$116.67 and an auctioneer's fee of \$3,500.00) with the Special Commissioner.

It is accordingly ADJUDGED, ORDERED and DERCREED that:

A. The Bid Price offered by the Highest Bidder for the Property is APPROVED;
B. The sale of the Property is CONFIRMED;
C. Upon full payment by the Highest Bidder, the Special Commissioner shall prepare, execute and deliver a special warranty deed conveying the property to the Highest Bidder and report their actions to the Court.

D. The Special Commissioner, upon receipt of the Highest Bidder's payment of \$38,616.67, is AUTHORIZED to issue checks on the funds as follows and to forward them to:
