Any person convicted of a second offense within less than five (5) years after a first offense of section 22-3.1 or 22-9 under this article shall be guilty of a 20 misdemeanor, punished by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00). Any 21 22 person convicted of a third offense within less than ten (10) years after a first offense 23 of section 22-3.1 or 22-9 under this article shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punished by a fine not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00). Any person 24 25 convicted of a violation of section 22-8 shall be guilty of a traffic offense, punished by 26 a fine not to exceed \$250.00. 27 28 . . . Sec. 22-8. – Reserved. Excessive noise in operation of vehicles. 29 It shall be unlawful for any person operating a vehicle within the city which either 1) is 30 equipped with a gutted muffler, muffler cutout, or straight exhaust in violation of 31 Virginia Code § 46.2-1047, or (2) which is not equipped with an exhaust system in 32 good working order and in constant operation to prevent excessive or unusual noise 33 34 levels in violation of Virginia Code § 46.2-1049, to create in the operation thereof any sound that is audible and discernable at a distance of 50 feet. 35 36 State Law Reference – Code of Virginia § 46.2-1051.
