

9. Additional information that will be helpful to reviewers:

While no match is officially required by this grant, HPD will be matching with \$3122.00 in order to fully utilize these funds and acquire 10 MDTs for patrol operations. According to the Office of Justice Programs grant application guide, "Voluntary match. If a successful application proposes a voluntary match amount, and OJP approves the budget, then the total match amount incorporated into the approved budget becomes mandatory and subject to audit" Thus the match becomes mandatory and will be drawn from budget code 01-310-290-06014.
