

5-Year Consolidated Plan

- 5-Year Consolidated Plan covers the City's FY2021-2025 budget years. City Council adopted the 5-year consolidated plan in May 2020.
- Each year, the City develops and submits an annual budget to HUD in the form of an Annual Action Plan. The FY23 Annual Action Plan is Year 3 of the Consolidated Plan.

<u>5-Year Consolidated Plan</u> Local Priorities

- To provide decent housing by
 - preserving the affordable housing,
 - reducing discriminatory barriers,
 - increasing the supply of supportive housing for those with special needs and
 - transitioning homeless persons and families into housing;

• To provide a **suitable living environment** through

- safer, more livable neighborhoods,
- greater integration of low and moderate income residents throughout the City,
- increased housing opportunities and reinvestment in deteriorating neighborhoods
- To expand economic opportunities through
 - more jobs paying self-sufficient wages,
 - homeownership opportunities,
 - development activities that promote low and moderate income persons to achieve self-sufficiency.

<u>Federal Funding</u> CDBG Objectives

<u>Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)</u> Development of viable urban communities by:

- providing decent housing,
- a suitable living environment, and
- economic opportunity principally for low to moderate income people.

CDBG's Broad National Objectives

- Benefit to low to moderate income persons,
- Aid in the prevention of slums and blight, or
- Meet an urgent need.



CDBG-CV Overview

- Awarded \$1,276,471
- Grant Agreements signed with HUD in May 2021
- Funds will be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus
- 80% of funds (~\$1 mil) expended within 3 years of grant agreement, 100% within 6 years

HOME ARP Overview

- Awarded \$1,954,965 April 2021
- Amount
 - 15% Administrative Set-Aside (~\$293k)
- Notice published September 2021
- Funds must be extended by September 2030

Qualifying Populations

1. Homeless

- 2. At-Risk of Homelessness
- Fleeing/Attempting to Flee Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Sexual Assault, Stalking or Human Trafficking
- 4. Other populations where assistance would prevent the family's homelessness or serve those with the greatest risk of housing instability

Veterans and families including a veteran member that meet one of the preceding criteria

Eligible Activities

- Rental Housing acquisition, construction and/or rehabilitation of rental housing
- Supportive Services provide a broad range of supportive services to qualifying individuals or families
- Tenant Based Rental Assistance pay the rent, security deposits, utility payments, and utility deposits
- Administration and Planning
- Non-Congregate Shelter
