Purpose of Today's Meeting

- Annual update of HRT's 10-year Transit Strategic Plan (TSP) required by DRPT
 - Last TSP update was completed in December 2021.
 - HRT is continuing with the December adoption timeframe to align with State requirements; therefore, this TSP annual update is scheduled for adoption in December 2022.
- This annual update will cover the period of FY 2024-FY 2033.
- HRT is briefing the City of Hampton on the planned service for FY 2023 and the route recommendations in this TSP update.



Recap: Current Service

- HRT entered into the Service Reliability Plan on May 9, 2021
 - Most Northside routes operating on a Sunday schedule on weekdays and Saturdays
 - As the agency moves back to normal service, goal is to focus on Northside service restoration first
- Service was restored on most Northside routes as of May 15, 2022, except:
 - Route 103 (awaiting restoration of 30-minute all day frequencies)
 - Route 104 (awaiting restoration of 30-minute all day frequencies)
 - Route 961 (awaiting restoration of 30-minute all day frequencies)
- HRT's ability to restore service is contingent upon operator availability



FY 2023 Service Plan




October 2022 (FY 2023) 757 Express Implementation

757 Express Group A service initial implementation (all paid for by HRRTF)

- Route 101
 - Realigned to operate between NNTC and HTC, no longer serving Northgate (the current 3:40 p.m. trip will be provided by an additional trip on Route 403).

Route 112

- 15-minute service will be provided during peak periods between 6th and Ivy and Patrick Henry Mall Monday through Friday.
- 30-minute service will be provided to Lee Hall from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- Weekday span improved to 5:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. and Sunday span improved to 5:15 a.m. to 12:30 a.m.





October 2022 (FY 2023) 757 Express Implementation (cont.)

757 Express Group A service initial implementation (all paid for by HRRTF)

- Route 403
 - One PM peak trip added (3:40 p.m.)
- Route 405
 - One trip added in the early period (5:40 a.m.) and one trip added in the PM peak period (3:30 p.m.)






May 2023 Plans (FY 2023)

757 Express Group A service implementation (all paid for by HRRTF)

- Route 101
 - 15-minute service will be provided during peak periods Monday through Friday.
 - Weekday span improved to 5:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. and Sunday span improved to 5:15 a.m. to 12:10 a.m.

Route 114

- 15-minute service will be provided during peak periods Monday through Friday.
- Improve weekday span to 5:00 a.m. to 1:00
 a.m. and weekend span improved to 6:00
 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.

PENINSULA: FY 2023 Group A HRRTF Implementation

Plan for Service Restoration in FY 2023

- Route 103 30-minute frequency restored during the early, AM peak, midday, PM peak, and evening periods on weekdays
- Route 104 30-minute frequency restored during the early, AM peak, midday, PM peak, and evening periods on weekdays
- Service restoration is dependent on the availability of operators. The restoration for Routes 103 and 104 are currently planned for the January 2023 and May 2023 service boards.




TSP 10-Year Plan Recommended Service Changes



FY 2024 Service Changes


- Route 115 is realigned to cover eliminated Route 117 and 120 and provide improved frequency and improved connections throughout Hampton.
 - Improve weekday span to start at 5:00 a.m. and Saturday span to 6:11 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.
 - Improve weekday peak headways to 30 minutes.
- Route 117 and 120 are eliminated.





FY 2024 Service Changes (cont.)

- Route 962 is introduced as part of the Norfolk redesign
 - Service provided between Evelyn T. Butts Transfer Center, Hampton, and Newport News on weekdays from 5:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., operated hourly.





FY 2025 Service Changes

- Routes realigned with span and/or headway improvements
 - Route 104
 - Route 105
 - Route 109
 - Route **110**
 - Route 111
- Route 115 weekday and weekend headway improvements.
- Route 102 and 118 are eliminated.
 - Routes 109, 111, and 114 provide coverage for Route 102.
 - Routes 109 and 114 provide coverage for Route 118.



FY 2026 Service Changes

Remainder of 757 Express Group A service implemented (all paid for by HRRTF)

Route 101

 Improve Saturday non-base, Sunday base, and Sunday non-base headways to 30 minutes.

Route 112

- Improve weekday midday, Saturday base, and Sunday base headway to 15 minutes between 6th and Ivy and Patrick Henry Mall.
- Improve weekday midday and Sunday non-base headways to 30 minutes between Patrick Henry Mall and Lee Hall.

Route 114

- Improve weekday midday, Saturday base, and Sunday base headways to 15 minutes.
- Improve weekday evening, Saturday non-base, and Sunday non-base headways to 30 minutes.

Other Service Changes

- Route 105 weekday headway improvements.
- Route 110 weekday, Saturday, and Sunday span improvements and weekday headway improvements.
- Route 115 Sunday span improvements

- Route 105 Sunday span improvements and Saturday headway improvements.
- Route 109 Saturday and Sunday span improvements.
- Route 110 weekday and weekend headway improvements

FY 2030

 Route 103 weekday and Sunday span improvements and Sunday headway improvements.

FY 2031

 Route 109 weekday headway improvements.

FY 2032

 Route 109 Saturday headway improvements


