WHEREAS: the Hampton Planning Commission has before it this day Use Permit

Application No. 18-00002 by Alisha Spratley-Thomas to permit the operation of a private school for approximately twenty (20) students at 66

W Mercury Boulevard [LRSN 8005697];

WHEREAS: the driving school would make use of a portion of an existing building;

WHEREAS: the applicant is proposing to offer a variety of drivers educational services

such as teen driving courses, behind the wheel trainings, and court-

ordered driver improvement courses for adults;

WHEREAS: the subject property is zoned Neighborhood Commercial (C-1), which

allows for private schools with an approved use permit;

WHEREAS: the Hampton Community Plan (2006, as amended) recommends

commercial uses for this area;

WHEREAS: the Hampton Community Plan includes economic development

objectives to attract and retain businesses;

WHEREAS: the Hampton Community Plan also indicates the importance of creating

a safe and caring community where youth have access to fun and educational opportunities that help prepare them for adulthood and a

desire to reinvest in their community;

WHEREAS: there are seven (7) conditions proposed to be attached to this use permit

application based on the proposed use's operational characteristics, including, among other things, a limitation of on-site parking of vehicles used for instructional use to no more than five (5) parking spaces to assure adequate parking for the building, and a capacity condition limiting the school to no more than 20 occupants or the maximum capacity

determined by a City building official, whichever is lower; and

WHEREAS: no one from the public spoke for or against this proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion by Commissioner Trina Coleman and seconded by

Commissioner Carole Garrison,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Hampton Planning Commission recommends to City Council approval of Use Permit Application No. 18-00002 with seven (7) conditions.
