WHEREAS: the Hampton Planning Commission has before it this day Zoning

Ordinance Amendment No. 18-00005 by the City of Hampton to Amend and Re-Enact Chapter 2 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Hampton, Virginia entitled "Definitions" by amending Section 2-2;

WHEREAS: approval of this amendment would add the definition of

pharmaceutical processor in the Zoning Ordinance;

WHEREAS: this item is proposed in conjunction with Zoning Ordinance

Amendment No. 18-00006, which would add pharmaceutical

processor to the use table in Chapter 3;

WHEREAS: this amendment is in response to the Virginia General Assembly's

new definition of a pharmaceutical processor, as well as the Virginia

Board of Pharmacy's Request for Proposals for these facilities;

WHEREAS: Section 54.1-3442.5 of the Code of Virginia defines a

pharmaceutical processor as "a facility that (i) has obtained a permit from the Board of Pharmacy pursuant to § 54.1-3408.3 of the Code of Virginia and (ii) cultivates cannabis plants intended only for the production of cannabidiol oil or THC-A oil, produces cannabidiol oil or THC-A oil, and dispenses cannabidiol oil or THC-A oil to a registered patient or, if such patient is minor or an incapacitated adult as defined in § 18.2-369 Code of Virginia, such patient's parent

or legal guardian.";

WHEREAS: staff is proposing to use the Virginia General Assembly's definition of

a pharmaceutical processor for consistency; and

WHEREAS: two members of the public spoke in favor of this proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion by Commissioner Carole Garrison and seconded

by Commissioner Trina Coleman,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Hampton Planning Commission recommends to City Council approval of Zoning Ordinance Amendment No. 18-00005.
