

## 5-Year Consolidated Plan Local Priorities

- Provide homeownership incentives
- Affirmatively further fair housing
- Stabilize and revitalize neighborhoods

## Federal Funding CDBG Objectives

#### Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

Development of viable urban communities by:

- providing decent housing,
- a suitable living environment, and
- economic opportunity principally for low to moderate income people.

### **CDBG's Broad National Objectives**

- Benefit to low to moderate income persons,
- Aid in the prevention of slums and blight, or
- Meet an urgent need.

## Federal Funding CDBG Revenues

**Anticipated FY2020 Local Allocation:** \$1,156,814

Estimated FY2020 Program Income: \$ 25,000

CDBG Reimbursement Allocation: \$ 100,000

CDBG TOTAL: \$1,281,814

# Federal Funding HOME Objectives

#### **HOME Investment Partnership Program**

- 1. Expand the supply of decent, safe, sanitary, and affordable housing;
- 2. Strengthen the ability of local governments to provide housing; and
- 3. Expand the capacity of non-profit community based housing development organizations.

## Federal Funding HOME Revenues

Anticipated FY2020 Local Allocation: \$557,513 Estimated FY2020 Program Income: \$230,000
