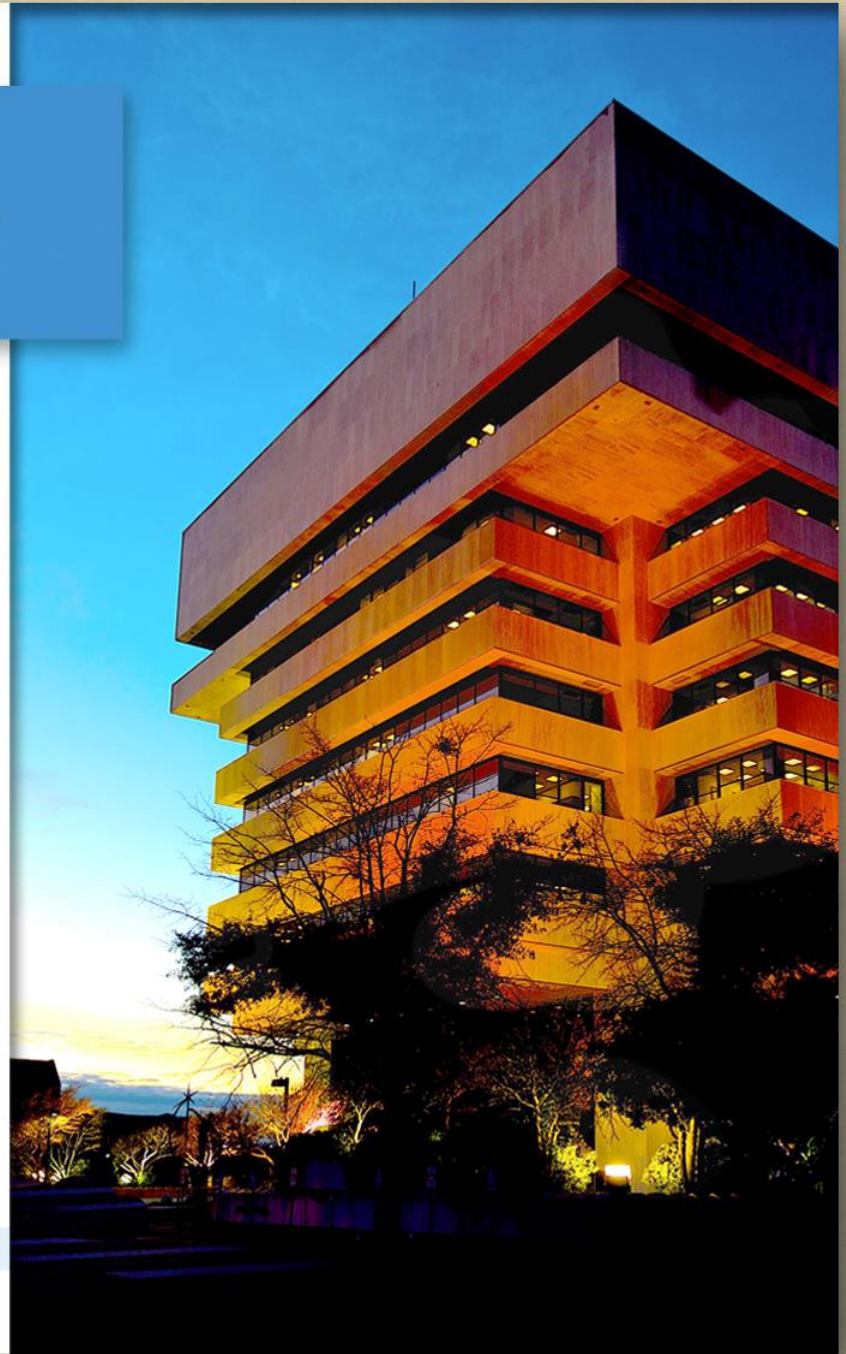

# *Federal Funding* *CDBG Objectives*

## Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

Development of viable urban communities by:

- providing decent housing,
- a suitable living environment, and
- economic opportunity principally for low to moderate income people.

## CDBG's Broad National Objectives

- Benefit to low to moderate income persons,
  - Aid in the prevention of slums and blight, or
  - Meet an urgent need.

# *Federal Funding* *HOME Objectives*

## HOME Investment Partnership Program

1. Expand the supply of decent, safe, sanitary, and affordable housing;
  2. Strengthen the ability of local governments to provide housing; and
  3. Expand the capacity of non-profit community based housing development organizations.

<b>Anticipated FY2020 Local Allocation:</b>	<b>\$557,513</b>
<b>Estimated FY2020 Program Income:</b>	<b>\$230,000</b>
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<b>HOME TOTAL:</b>	<b>\$787,513</b>

<u>Acquisition/Rehabilitation</u>	<u>\$557,375</u>

<u>Community Housing Development Org.</u>	<u>\$83,626</u>
<u>Administration (10%)</u>	<u>\$36,512</u>
