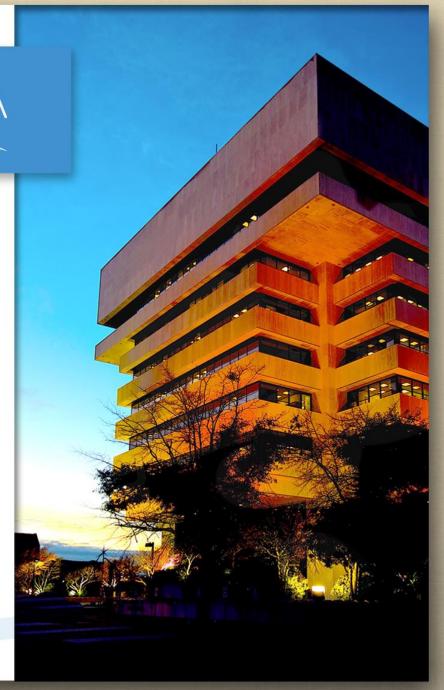

- ✓ Marketing and Outreach: 1 Social Media Coordinator
- ✓ Public Works Engineering: 1 Surveyor
