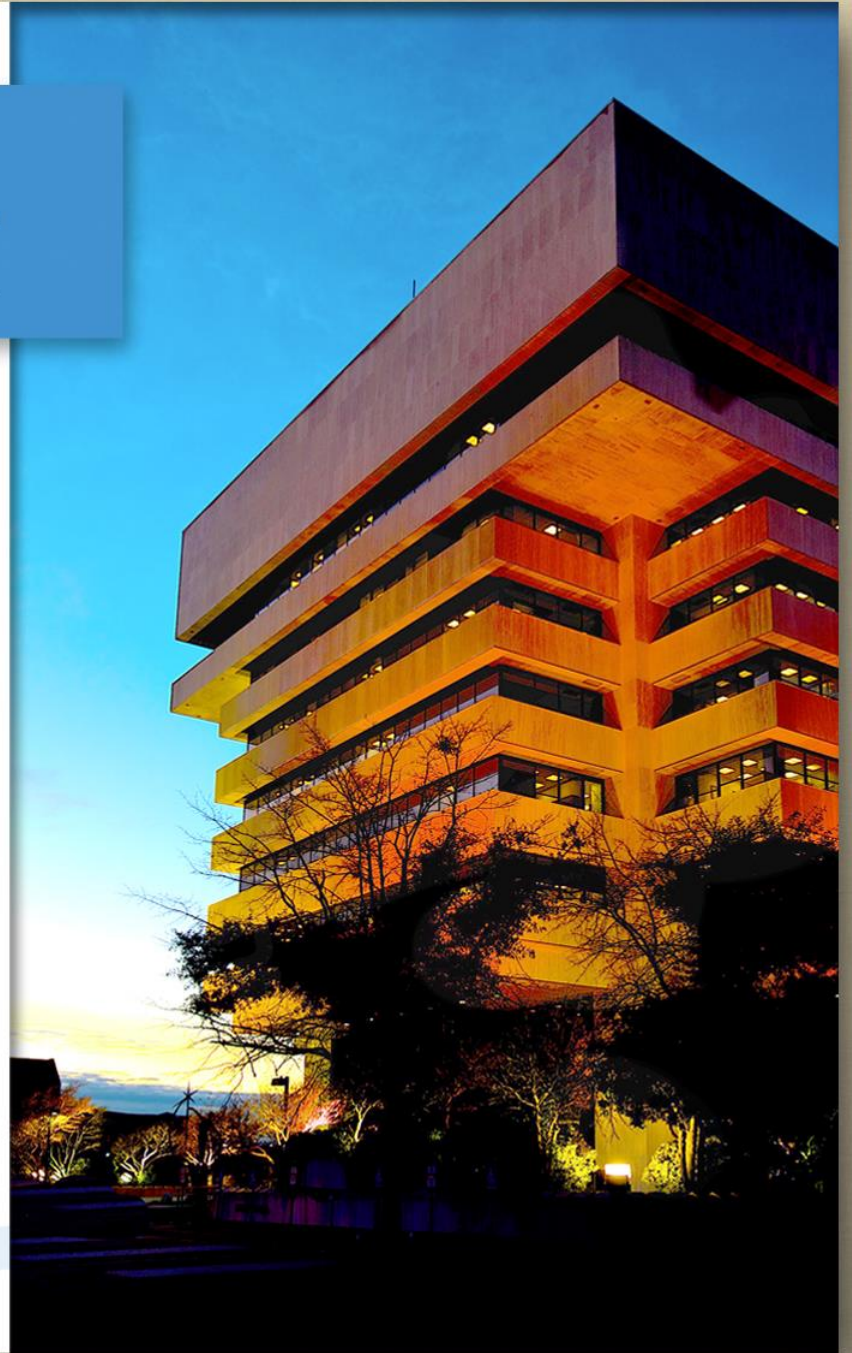

Smart Scale Overview

- SMART SCALE program uses State and Federal tax dollars to fund projects that meet critical transportation needs in Virginia
- Projects are scored and ranked statewide using objective data-driven prioritization process
- Applications due by August 3, 2020
- If selected, project(s) will be included in the next VDOT Six-Year Improvement Program and funding will become available beginning in FY26

Identifying Candidate Projects

SMART SCALE Program criteria:

- Improve Congestion Problems
 - New roadway alignment
 - Turn lane improvements
- Address Safety Concerns
 - New bike & pedestrian facilities

Previously Selected Projects

- Coliseum Drive Extension Phase A
 - Hampton Roads Center Parkway to Butler Farm Road
- Little Back River Road Corridor Improvements
 - King Street to Clemwood Parkway
 - Clemwood Parkway to Harris Creek Road
- Power Plant Parkway Sidewalks
 - Briarfield Road to Pine Chapel Road
- Hampton Roads Center Parkway Pedestrian Improvements
 - Coliseum Drive to Armistead Avenue
- Armistead Avenue Pedestrian Improvements
 - Convention Center Boulevard to LaSalle Avenue

To: Neil Armstrong Parkway* (at North Campus Parkway)
- North Campus Parkway Bicycle & Pedestrian Improvements
From: Neil Armstrong Parkway* (at North Campus Parkway)
To: Neil Armstrong Parkway* (at Floyd Thompson Drive)
- North King Street Corridor Improvements (Segment 5)
From: Quash Street
To: Old Fox Hill Road

*Effective July 1, 2021: Magruder Boulevard will officially be renamed Neil Armstrong Parkway (approved Resolution 20-0005)

Coliseum Drive Extension (Phase B)

From: Butler Farm Road

To: Neil Armstrong Parkway*

- City's Comprehensive Plan (1989)
- Mercury Central Plan (1994)
- Coliseum Central Master Plan (2004)
- Continue extension of Coliseum Drive
- 4-lane divided road & shared-used path
- Connect Hampton Roads Center North to Coliseum Central

FY22 Candidate Projects



North Campus Parkway Bicycle & Pedestrian Improvements

From: Neil Armstrong Pkwy* at N. Campus Pkwy
To: Neil Armstrong Pkwy* at Floyd Thompson Drive

- Shared-use path south of Commander Shepard Boulevard
 - Connect to existing Matteson Trail
 - Connect to proposed Coliseum Drive Extension shared-use path
- Install missing sidewalk north of Commander Shepard Boulevard along North Campus Parkway and Floyd Thompson Drive

FY22 Candidate Projects

North King Street Corridor Improvements (Segment 5)

From: Quash Street

To: Old Fox Hill Road



- North King Street Master Plan (2007)
- Install last segment of shared-use path between Downtown and Langley Air Force Base gate
- Provide safe pedestrian access to existing bus stops on East side of North King Street

- Adopt resolution of support for VDOT FY22 SMART SCALE Program Funds for three projects
