The Virginia Highway Safety Office (VAHSO) provides grants for programs which are designed to reduce the number of crashes, injuries, fatalities, and related economic losses resulting from traffic crashes on Virginia's roadways through a sub-grant provided by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA). Priority areas for the FY2021 grant year include: impaired driving, occupant protection, speeding, and pedestrian and bike safety. The Hampton Police Division will be applying for occupant protection, which will allow the Division to supplement manning with officer overtime, as approved.

Virginia's Highway Safety Program is entered into agreement between the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) and the City of Hampton. This is a pass through grant due to the DMV being allocated funds by the U.S. Department of Transportation National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA). The agreement is outlined in the Highway Safety Grant Agreement award and until such time as awarded, is not available (per VAHSO). In-kind match is required at 50% of the grant funding awarded and may fluctuate (decrease) if award is for less than amount requested.



This application is for \$4,277.00 in grant funding and \$2,138.50 as an in-kind match provided in fuel and maintenance to our fleet vehicles. The period of performance is for 12 months. No additional costs are anticipated. This is a pass-through grant that is allocated to the Commonwealth/DMV by the federal government.
