

Buckroe Boardwalk Renovations: Council Guidance



- ✓ Leave seawall at approximately its current height
- ✓ Extend boardwalk from Point Comfort Avenue to James T. Wilson Fishing Pier, without parking spaces (\$1.1 million/75 year life)
- ✓ Improve seawall, boardwalk surface, planters, ADA, lighting & plantings
- ✓ Modify reconstruction option (\$6 million/50-year life)
- ✓ Use neutral design
- ✓ Preserve existing views (no new trees on boardwalk, etc.)
- ✓ Update plan to incorporate citizen amenity preferences such as swings and shaded seating, etc.
- ✓ Engage landscape design firm with beach experience to assist in selecting amenities.
- ✓ Shift CIP funding to FY21 to move project forward
