SELF-INSURED ENTITY



The City of Hampton is self-insured with limits as shown below:

Liability losses are retained to \$1,000,000 with an excess insurance policy of up to \$10,000,000.

Workers' Compensation losses are retained to \$1,000,000 with an excess insurance policy of up to \$50,000,000




Work closely with the City Attorney's Office and Human
