Resolution of the City Council of Hampton, Virginia to Amend the Approved Fiscal Year 2020 Council Approved Budget by Accepting and Appropriating \$547,000 in Grant Funds Awarded by the Virginia Department of Emergency Management to the City of Hampton, Virginia to Elevate One (1) Severe Repetitive Loss Property, Grant FMA-PJ-03-VA-2018-002, awarded December 20, 2019

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Virginia Department of Emergency Management (VDEM) is the recipient of certain federal funds from the Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA) Grant Program. VDEM subsequently sub-awards those federal funds to Virginia localities through the FMA Grant Program. This grant allows the Office of Emergency Management to contract for elevation of a severe repetitive loss property in the City of Hampton to reduce the risk of flood loss to the elevated property and the National Flood Insurance Program. This supports the 2017 Hampton Roads Hazard Mitigation Plan Goal 1, Objective 1.1, to reduce damage to repetitively flooded properties. This grant is for \$547,000 with no local match required.

Discussion:

The lowest finished floor will be elevated to provide protection from 1% annual flood level plus an additional three-foot freeboard requirement. The project will reduce claims to the National Flood Insurance Program and protect the health and safety of the residents while reducing demand on City public safety resources during disasters.

Impact:

This grant is for \$547,000 with no local match required.

Recommendation:

Approve.

WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Emergency Management has awarded the Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant Program titled “City of Hampton, Elevation of 1 Property” to the City of Hampton in the amount of \$547,000 with no local match required for a total grant amount of \$547,000; and

WHEREAS, the grant award covers the period December 20, 2019 through April 1, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Hampton, Virginia hereby amends its Fiscal Year 2020 Council Approved Budget to accept and appropriate the Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant titled, “City of Hampton, Elevation of 1 Property FMA-03-VA-2018-002” from the Virginia Department of Emergency Management in the amount of \$547,000, and any related supplemental funding, to the Grant Fund in accordance with the grant agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the City Manager or her designee to take the necessary steps to implement this grant award.
