Mugler, Commissioner of the Revenue for the City of Hampton v. Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless, where such briefing in an open meeting would adversely affect the negotiating or litigating posture of the city ; and to consult with legal counsel employed by the city regarding specific legal matters concerning, development agreements, real property rights and substandard lot zoning regulations that require the provision of legal advice by such counsel.
