Title: Closed session pursuant to Virginia Code Sections 2.2-3711.A.1,.3, .6, .7 and .8 to discuss appointments as indicated on the agenda; discussion or consideration of the acquisition of real property for a public purpose in the Wythe, Coliseum Central, and Downtown areas of the City where discussion in an open meeting would adversely affect the bargaining position or negotiating strategy of the public body; discussion or consideration of the investment of public funds where competition or bargaining is involved, where, if made public initially, the financial interest of the governmental unit would be adversely affected; consultation with legal counsel pertaining to actual or probable litigation, where such consultation or briefing in an open meeting would adversely affect the negotiating or litigation posture of the public body; and for consultation with legal counsel employed or retained by a public body regarding specific legal matters related to coastal resiliency efforts requiring the provision of legal advice by such counsel.
