Resolution to Amend the Fiscal Year 2020 Council Approved Budget and Accept and Appropriate the Fiscal Year 2019 Local Emergency Management Performance ("LEMP") Grant as Awarded by the Virginia Department of Emergency Management to the City of Hampton, Virginia ("City")

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The purpose of this resolution is to amend the Fiscal Year 2020 Council Approved Budget and accept and appropriate state grant funds and certain in-kind services to permit continuation of the Office of Emergency Management's Comprehensive Emergency Management Program ("Program").

Discussion:

The Local Emergency Management Performance ("LEMP") Grant has been awarded to the City of Hampton, Virginia's ("City") Office of Emergency Management ("OEM") annually for the purpose of supporting the City's Comprehensive Emergency Management Program ("Program"). The Program includes training and education for City staff and volunteers; and planning assistance for the OEM including that for home elevations, and technology to support emergency operations all in an effort to better prepare for future threats. The 2019 LEMP Grant award is \$90,654 with a required local in-kind or cash match of \$90,654. The OEM has chosen to meet the required match through in-kind contributions from City resources that provide staff time to support our City's Comprehensive Emergency Management program.

Impact:

State funds in the amount of \$90,654; Local In-Kind Match of \$90,654

Recommendation:

Accept and appropriate grant funds

WHEREAS, the City of Hampton, Virginia's ("City") Office of Emergency Management ("OEM") applied for and has been awarded the 2019 Local Emergency Management Performance ("LEMP") grant funds through the Virginia Department of Emergency Management in furtherance of the OEM's Comprehensive Emergency Management Program ("Program"); and

WHEREAS, the grant award for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 includes \$90,654 in state funds and requires a \$90,654 cash or in-kind match ("LEMP Match") from local resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Hampton, Virginia amends its Fiscal Year 2019 Council Approved Budget to accept and appropriate to the Grant Fund \$181,308, to include the grant of \$90,654 in state funds and matching in-kind services in the amount of \$90,654, and any supplemental funding, awarded by the Virginia Department of Emergency Management to the Grant Fund in accordance with the grant program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Hampton, Virginia authorizes the City Manager, or her designee, to take any and all actions necessary to implement this grant award.
